Comparing Penetrating VS Film Forming

MOUNTAIN XT

OR

RAINFOREST and MOUNTAIN XT



- Affordable, very beautiful Flat sheen
- Flexible, resilient resins let wood breathe
- Petrification effect when maintained
- Easy one coat process. It will never peel.
- Spot Maintainable. No stripping.
- Pressure wash and recoat. No film to sand.
- Penetrating sealers need more maintenance but less prep in order to that maintenance.
- Lasts longer if a film is applied over it.

- Beautiful, honey gloss protective film
- Up to 750 Sft per gallon
- Easiest to apply after a coat of Rainforest
- More protection than a base coat alone
- More Water, Mildew, Fungi resistant film
- Not spot maintainable but more washable
- Will last longer but films on the surface of wood require more prep, like sanding, before recoating.
- MUST be inspected and recoated to keep the film in good condition or it will be harder to re-coat.
- If maintained it will be a longer lasting and better finish. If you are not willing to do yearly inspections use a Penetrating coat of XT.
